Escape Rooms are a collaborative learning game in which students work in teams to solve a series of puzzles, collect codes or keys, and somehow compile their information to "escape" the scenario. They can be as simple or complex, it depends on the topic.

An escape room is an exciting and adventurous game in which participants are "locked" into a themed room with their team, and they must solve riddles, puzzles, and clues in order to find their way out of the room before the time runs out.
