- **ability** – something you can do it, e.g write or sing / **umiejętność** / **habilidade**
- **antonym** – a word that means the opposite of another word / **antonim** / **antônimo**
- **bizarre** – strange and difficult to explain / **dziwny** / **estranhas**
- **coat of arms** – a special design tah a school or other organization uses / **herb** / **braços**
- **cooperation** - working together to achieve a result / **współpraca**/ **cooperação**
- **difference** – something that makes one thing or person not the same as another thing or person / **różnica** / **diferença**
- **different** – not the same as another person or thing, or not the same as before / **różny, inny** / **diferente**
- **dissimilarity** – the way in which two people or things are different from each other / **różnorodność** / **diversidade**
- **distinction** – a difference between two things / **rozróżnienie, odróżnienie** / **distinção, distinção**
- **divide** – to do a Mathemalital calculation / **podzielić** / **dividir**
- **dough** – a mixture of flour, water etc that is baked to make bread / **ciasto** / **bolo, massa**
- **dumplings** – a small solid cooked food made from flour and water / **pieróg, kluska** / **bolinho**

- **exclusion** – an action of not accepting someone or something and not including him/ her in a group / **wykluczenie** / **exclusão**
- **exaggerated** – to tell about something in a way that makes it seem better, worse, larger or more important / **przesadzony** / **exagerado**
- **extraordinary** – very unusual and surprising / **niezwykły** / **fora do normal**
- **freedom** – the right to do what you want and make your own decisions / **wolność** / **liberdade**
- **hint** – something you say to show what you are thinking or feeling / **podpowiedź** / **dica**
- **important** – affecting someone's life / **ważny** / **importante**
- **inclusion** – an action of accepting someone or something and including him/ her in a group / **włączenie** / **inclusão**
- **inhabitant** – a person who lives in a particular place / **mieszkaniec** / **habitante**
- **international** – involving many countries / **międzynarodowy** / **internacional**
- **Jews** – a member of the group of people who lived in Israel / **Żyd** / **Judeu**
- **knead** – to prepare dough by squeezing or pressing it continuously / **wyrobić, wygnieść np. Ciasto** / **amassar, por exemplo, uma massa**
- **multicultural society** – involving or consisting of people of different cultures / **wielokulturowe społeczeństwo** / **sociedade multicultural**
- **Municipal Office** – a place where local government is located / **Urząd Gminy** / **Escritório municipal**
- **odd** – unusual or unexpected / **dziwny** / **estranhas**
- **pastry** – a food made by mixing flour, fat and water / **ciasto** / **bolo, massa**
- **sift** – to pour a dry substance through a sieve to remove the large pieces / **przesiać** / **peneirar**
- **similar** – things or people that are similar share some qualities but are not exactly the same / **podobny** / **como**

- **stereotype** - to believe that someone has a particular character only because this is what many people believe and not because you know anything about their character or personality / **stereotyp** / **estereótipo**
- **tolerance** – to accept other people's beliefs, way of life without criticising them, even if we don't agree with them / **tolerancja** / **tolerância**
- **unique** – very special / **wyjątkowy** / **excepcjonal**
- **unusual** – not normal, not common or ordinary / **niezwykły** / **fora do normal**
- **yolk** – the middle part of an egg that is yellow / **żółtko** / **gema**

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
